Demonstration in oils

Judy Soprano took two very interesting plein air workshops. One was with David Dunlop who has a PBS series on the Hudson River School. The other was with Jim Wilcox, an award winning artist from Jackson Hole, WY. Judy will demo in oil, pointing out techniques she learned from both artists. Don't miss this exciting demo.

Artist Statement: *"I opened the door to my creativity and found my soul"*

I love the way farmers construct their barns and sheds. I find it very creative for a barn to be built, then the add-ons come as the years go by and the need arises. Our barn was the playground for my brothers and me. It was our Tarzan swing, our fort for cowboys and Indians and our castle for the king and queen.

My next love is trees. I love them in the winter when you can see their bones creating those long shadows. The way shadows run across the land....I can see them moving when I paint them into a winter scene. Shadows tell me how the land lies, how it rises and falls across the bumps and ruts in the back lane of our farm.

I love to travel. In recent years I have been to Maine twice, Alaska, France, Italy and Great Britain and painted in all those places but I always come back to paint my barns.

The greatest compliment I ever received was when my nephew at age 9 said he could ride a bike down the road in one of my paintings. For a landscape painter that was the best compliment ever because that little boy saw depth in the scene on the flat surface of the canvas. How exciting!

I work in both oil and watercolor but I love to draw...my sketchpad is my constant companion.

I cannot think of a better way to say it and it sounds like very poor grammar, but I can't not paint. I feel that my life has been enriched in many ways, my husband, my children and my obsession of creating art.

Art Shows at Summer Festivals

As the membership is well aware, the number of SRAG art shows has steadily decreased over the past few years. It has occurred to me that our Group has had minimal presence in two fairly popular local events - namely, the Brockport Arts Festival and Spencerport Canal Days. I suspect that the entry costs for these events discourages individual participation. I've contacted the chairs of both these events to determine whether their rules restrict multiple artists sharing display spaces for their events.

Chair of the Brockport Arts Festival has responded that they do not have such restrictions. My thought is that, as an organization, we could request two adjacent spaces, erect two abutting tents, and have participating SRAG members share the entry costs. Details of the 2017 event are:

Dates: August 12 - 13, 2017

Price: \$175 (one 10x10 tent); \$300 (two 10x10 tents); a standard discount of \$25 if the application and fees are received on or before March 14, 2017.
