Please bring the following:

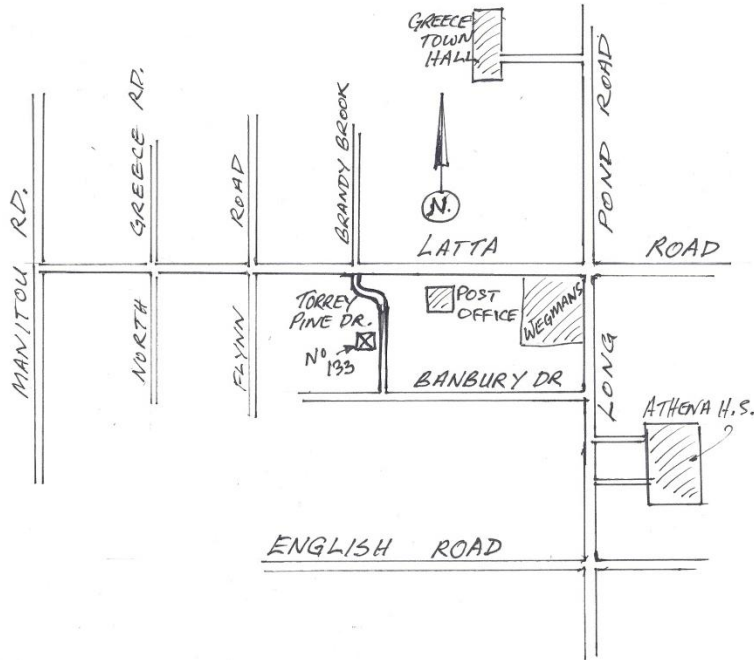
- * A dish to pass; (*there will be some refrigerator space available*).

Here is some info about a place for artists to display/sell their artwork. This is strictly a fine arts show/sale. This outdoor show will be held at Willow Park in the town of Sodus. You provide your own canopy and if you haven't one you can still set up your racks. There is not a lot of shade there so you will need to provide for your own comfort. Restrooms and parking nearby.

The dates and the contact person/phone number are listed below. You have the option of choosing which Saturday you want or doing all six Saturday shows. There is no charge but you must make your reservations. The artist hosting these shows lives and works in Sodus. His name is Mike Novik...he is a watercolorist and has a gallery in the town. He sent the following:

I am hosting 6 Art Shows this 2013 Summer Season, here in The Village of Sodus Point, on "Lake Ontario & Beautiful Sodus Bay". Each Show will be held the 2nd and 4th Saturdays of June, July, and August, 9am - 5pm with the rain date the very next day "Sunday". Sodus Point is just a one hour drive from both Rochester and Syracuse. The New York Thruway/I-90 is 25 minutes to the South. All Artists are welcome to show their work FREE of charge.
