My demo on Wed. night will be on the many forms of graphite and materials that I use in a graphite drawing. I will do a demo of how I approach the beginning of a graphite drawing by establishing the basic value shapes. John Whalley is a Maine artist who does graphite drawings in a very realistic way. I have studied his work to help me to learn how to use the medium.

I have been a member of SRAG for 41 years and a member of Rochester Colored Pencil Club, Rochester Art Club and Main Street Artists. My media currently are colored pencil, graphite, acrylics and oils. Landscapes of the Adirondacks and Maine are my main subjects but I do an occasional still life.
