Spring Show, New Rules

Suburban Rochester Art Group Judging Guidelines *Artwork is to be judged_by using these criteria*

- Technical skill
- Composition
- Perspective
- Originality
- Presentation
- Each artist has their own section to hang. Artwork represented by the individual artist fall under many categories. Although we do not judge in categories we encourage our members to widen their creative vision by trying different media;
- Water media
- Oil-acrylic
- Pastel
- colored pencil
- Drawing- Pen &ink, graphite, charcoal, scratchboard, etc.
- Experimental
- Mixed Media
- Original Prints
- 3-dementional or sculpture

Awards; Best of Show, 1st, 2nd, & 3rd plus The SRAG Award (a special award given to an individual artist for best overall display). All the above are monetary awards. All awards plus Honorable Mention receive a ribbon.

There is also The Popular Award which is a special award chosen by the group members through a ballet system.

- Only one monetary award can be given to an individual artist with exception of the SRAG Award.
- Honorable Mentions can be given as the judge feel deserve them even to an artist already receiving a money award keeping in mind the fairness to all artists that participate in this show.
