DIRECTIONS:

Go North on Manitou Rd. Go past the 4 way stop flashing lights with the gas station on the corner, then Turn right on to Hincher Rd. (5.4 miles N. from rte 104.)

After 0.6 miles Turn left on Hogan Point Rd.

On the left, before you reach the Dead End of Hogan Point Rd, you will see a faded sign saying Burger Park. Turn left and continue to the end, where there is obvious parking.

The park is fairly small (now belongs to the Town of Greece, and not the Burger family), but has a lot of painting opportunities and a nice gravel path.

There is a raised viewing platform at the entrance to the park. Water views and beautiful trees and distance vistas.

If you have a wagon and are willing to walk down the path for less than 1/2 a mile, there will be more options. Salmon Creek, water lilies, reeds etc etc.

Good options, whether you want to step out of your car to paint, or whether you are willing to walk a short, easy distance. No bathrooms!
