Meeting February 15, 2017 Cindy Arnold. Painting with Paper

The **February 15** meeting is on 'Painting with Paper', a collage technique. Please note the date as it is the **3rd Wednesday**. Think of a simple idea to start: flower, simple landscape/seascape as it is easy to get too complicated and get discouraged. In advance of the meeting Cindy and I are asking you to cut/tear color swatches from magazines, gift wrap, tissue paper, greeting cards etc. It can be images or just swatches of paper. Also old watercolor paintings can be re-colored or just cut/torn to use. Any kind of paper can be used as we are using paper in place of paint. If you can go to the **Pinterist** site and search paper collage or just search collage art there are great examples; ours will be simpler. Also bring **scissors but you can also tear the paper**, glue, tweezers (to help handle the glued paper). Cindy will have **backing board**, and both Cindy and Nina will have glue, cut up paper tissue paper etc.

Individual artist's cost: Cost of tent{s) divided by number of SCRAG exhibitors. **Number of art pieces per exhibitor:** Depends on member participation and size of their pieces.

Tent Locations: Main Street – both sides (from the canal to College St.)

Setting-up: Cars/vans are allowed on the street on Friday evening and early Saturday morning for set-up.

Parking: Available on the side streets and in village lots.

A seating schedule will be compiled.
