SRAG Needs a Program Committee for 2018

It is only the start of 2017 but I feel that the time has come to pass the program duties to other members starting in January 2018. This is a fun job: researching, talking with local artists and scheduling them for meetings. Ideally there should be 2 people working together on this so that all details are covered. If the new program committee could be in place by summer it would be an easy transfer in scheduling meetings.

Posted below are the duties of the Program Committee: Program Chair Duties

- This position should be for 2 people as one needs to cover when other can't attend meetings or share in deciding the program for the upcoming year. Programs run from January to November with a picnic in June and Christmas Party in December.
- Compile a list of artists to do demos. A file currently exists with names and contact information. Additional artists can be listed by visiting art shows and talking with artists whose work you like or find interesting. Check area art groups web site for their program listing.
- In the fall the Greece Town Office gives dates for meetings in the coming year. Currently Ed Howe is their contact.
- Start to contact artists giving them options of dates. Try for a mix of subjects (landscape, portraits, still life etc.) and mediums used (oil, watercolor, pastel etc.). Keep in mind restrictions such as open flame and messy mediums. Try to have some SRAG members demo or give a slide show or talk. Program times run from 7PM to 8:45PM. We must be out of the Town Hall by 9PM.
- While there is no set budget, it has cost between \$900 and \$1000 per year.
- When contacted artists agree to a date and that the honorarium is \$50 for SRAG Member and \$100 for others. Send an email to confirm.
- About 2 months in advance contact artist and ask for a short bio or artist statement for the newsletter. Forward this info about 1 month in advance to newsletter editor.
- One Month: Ask if artist needs any special equipment. We do have an overhead mirror stored at Anne McCune's. It is quite heavy and takes time to assemble so don't volunteer that there is one but if they ask for it make arrangements to get it to the Town Hall. Terry Brooks has a computer with a projector for power point. The artist needs to have their own flash drive or CD.

- Two Weeks: Check to see if artist needs directions. Agree on time (usually 6 to 6:30 PM) and be at Town Hall to meet them and assist them. If they arrive before 6:30 they can start to set up but if the meeting has started there will be a break at about 7PM.
- Contact treasurer with artist name and amount of check.
- There is a file with past programs listed and comments and fee paid. This also contains suggestions like ask again for a different presentation.

Presently the 4th Wednesday of the month is for the Board meeting and a work night. Members can work on their projects or do something from the previous meeting demo.

Upcoming Brockport Arts Fest to be held August 12-13, 2017.
