SRAG Plein Air Landscape Workshop with Chris Kolupski Saturday, August 2, 2014 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM

Dear SRAG Member,

SRAG will be offering a workshop to be held at the Lakeview Community Church, which is located at 30 Long Pond Road. (Long Pond and Edgemere Drive, across from the fire station. Chris Kolupski will be working in oils, hopefully en plein air. He will be demonstrating light and shadow and the transition area known as penumbra. In case of rain bring photos to use as a basis for your painting. Photos with strong light and shadow pattern will work best.

This is labeled as a landscape workshop but it is about the transition area from light to shade and how the shadow softens at the edges. If you saw Chris demo at the SRAG meeting in February then you know that you can use the information in still life, floral and other subjects.

PROGRAM: Demo in the morning, lunch break, work in the afternoon. Arrive at 8:30 to have a ½ hr. set up time and allow a ½ hr. clean up time at 4 p.m. Each artist must bring all of their own materials (any medium) and easel if needed, plus bug spray, sun screen etc. for outside. Also bring sketch paper to use for notes and thumbnail sketches. A camera will be helpful.

We will have the use of round tables, use of the kitchen with a refrigerator (for those who bring a cold lunch), coffee and hot water (for tea) will be provided. There is a bathroom.

Workshop limited to 20 people on a first come first serve basis, so return your application with your fee ASAP.
