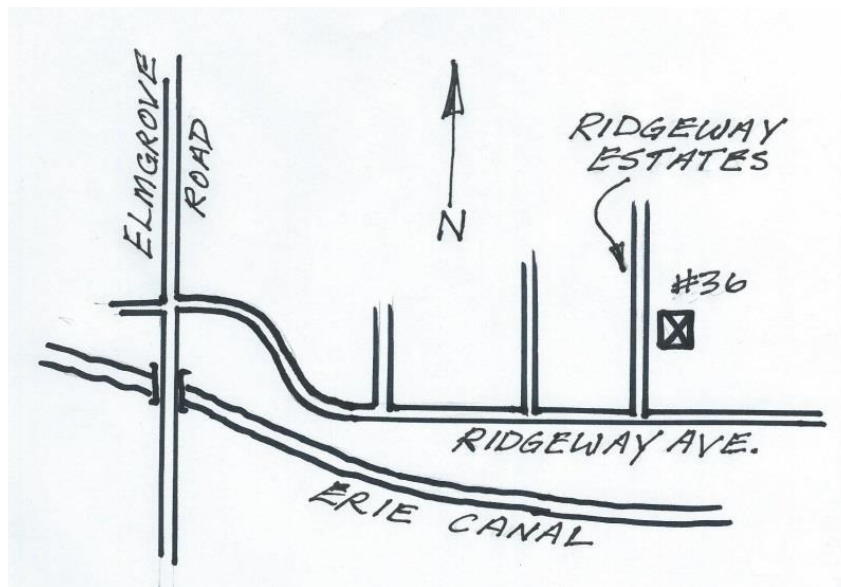
May 14, 2014 Meeting
