Yes, it's back! Food, merriment and camaraderie!





Paul Taylor Workshop

<u>Line and Wash with Watercolor – Matchstick approach</u>

Saturday, November 19, 2022 9:00 am-12:00 pm @ Village Gallery Studio, 3096 Main Street, Caledonia. NY 14423 \$25.00 pp, payable the day of class. Cash or check. Max. 10, Min 5.

The use of a dynamic line drawing with ink, will essentially make the process of creating a watercolor painting easier. With the varied line of the drawing tool and the simplicity of painting the shapes, the image becomes stylized as the line supports the color but disguises minor errors by making them appear intentional.

Students in the class will learn to block in a subject in light pencil followed by the line with ink. If you struggle with watercolor this may just be the ticket for you. Paul will guide you through the steps as the drawing is created and the watercolor is added. Paul's steps of the painting will be easily seen on a

monitor so you don't miss anything.

All materials including palette, paint, paper, brushes and more will be provided.

Just bring yourself.
