## SRAG business

A board meeting was held on July 8, 2020 at the home of Cheri Riley,

Al Bergerson distributed his proposed update to the SRAG by laws for perusal by the Board. This is an attempt to simplify the legal type language and make the document more relevant and easier to understand.

**Eleanor Milborrow** is now the Chairperson of the Board. Other board members present were Al Bergerson, Juanita Link, Betsy Ogles, Debbie Cooper, Terry Brooks, and Cheri Riley. The main topic for the meeting was to discuss ideas for attracting and keeping new members to SRAG. **Some of the ideas proposed were**:

1. That the name of the group be changed to include the word "Greece" or "Greece Area" in its title, to indicate the locale from which it draws its membership. It was thought that the present title was conceived when there were no other art groups in the

area. It was pointed out that now each town has its own art club with the name of that town prominent in the title. (Chili, Irondequoit, Pittsford, and Penfield) for example, and that a person living in the Greece area would more likely join a club with Greece in its title.

- 2. Open the group to include all forms of fine art: including photography, digital art, print making, jewelry, ceramics, sculpture, and others. This would bring us in line with other groups in the area.
- 3. Contact other groups to discover why they are more successful than we are.
- 4. **Exploit our "Facebook" page**, with more content. Pictures and other content can be sent to Debbie Cooper.
- 5. Old records show that SRAG used to give a \$100 scholarship to an art student to create interest in the group and bring in younger people. Should this be considered again?
- 6. We are hoping to resume meetings in September. This is dependent on whether the Town of Greece meeting rooms will be open by then.
- 7. Suggestion for group to participate in Artist's Row at the Public Market in 2021: it's too late to try for this year.

Items 1. And 2 would, of course, be a topic of discussion for the whole membership. The other items will be followed up by the board members and others who are interested in getting them resolved.

The Oxford Gallery is now open with a theme exhibit entitled "Coming Home". This exhibit involves interpretations of the theme by over 50 artists. The exhibit is now on view through Saturday, September 12.

There are 24 hanging rods, although 2 paintings could be hung on a few of the rods. There is also a glass display case where small pieces or note cards etc could be placed.

The likelihood would be 1 or 2 pieces per member, although this would be dependent on how many people participate.

Last year Terry sent out an email to see how many people were interested, and we had a very good response. As we are all painfully aware, COVID 19 has changed everything this year, and if you responded positively last year, you are in no way obligated to enter the show now. It is whatever you are comfortable with, bearing in mind you will not have to deliver your own work, or hang it, or pick it up.
