I hope my paintings inspire in the viewer empathy and respect for our natural environment, for animals, and for each other.

I spent 30 years as an illustrator of more than 24 picture books, as well as book covers and magazine stories. Now I focus my time on my own paintings and commissioned work.

I also enjoy teaching art to individuals and groups, in my home as well as at Pat Rini

Rohrer Gallery in Canandaigua, NY. I've learned how to explain the intuitive process of creating art so that my students can grow as artists.

When not in the studio, I'm an avid reader. I play piano and love hearing live music. I have two grown children that I'm overly proud of. I enjoy hiking with my husband and our rescued dog in the woods surrounding our log home in New York's Finger Lakes region.
